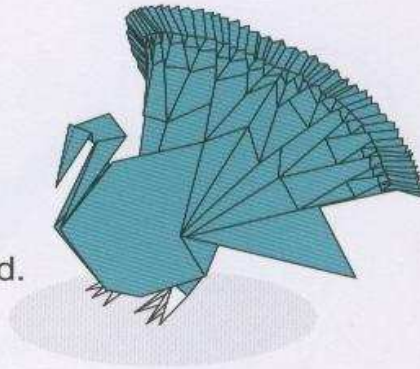


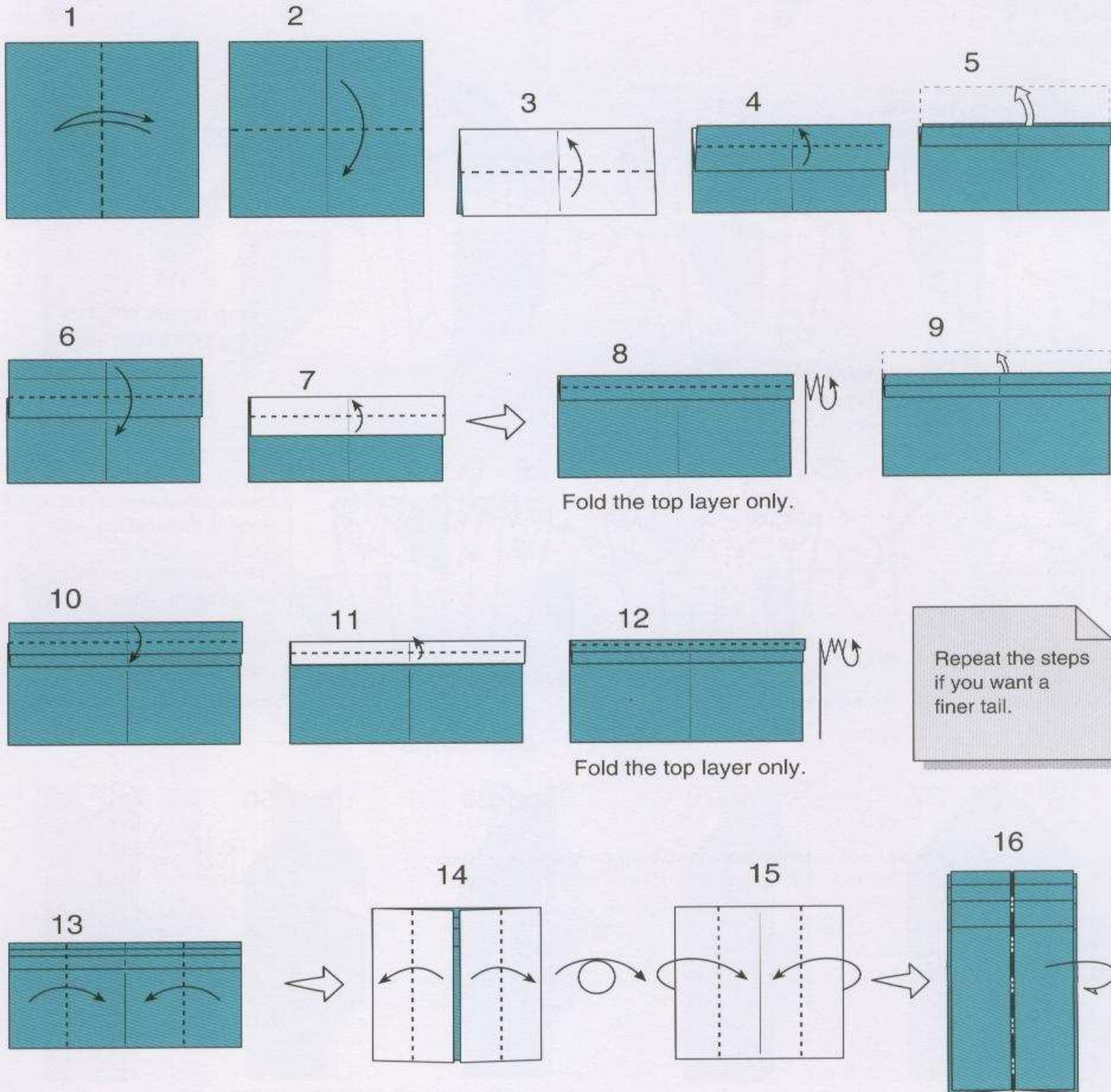

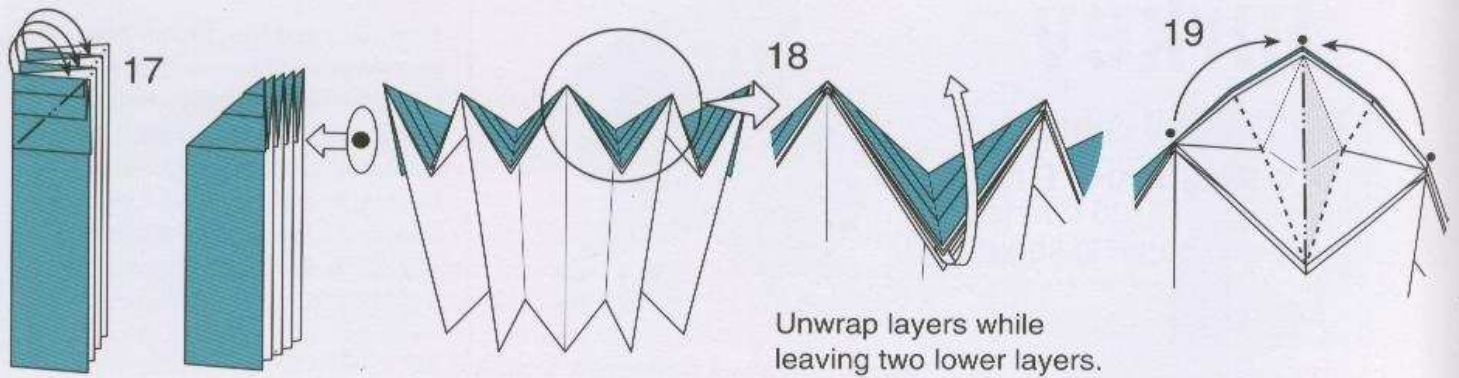
Theme: Self-similar

Difficult to fold using 6" (15 cm) origami paper. 10" (25 cm) to 12" (30 cm) very thin paper is suggested.



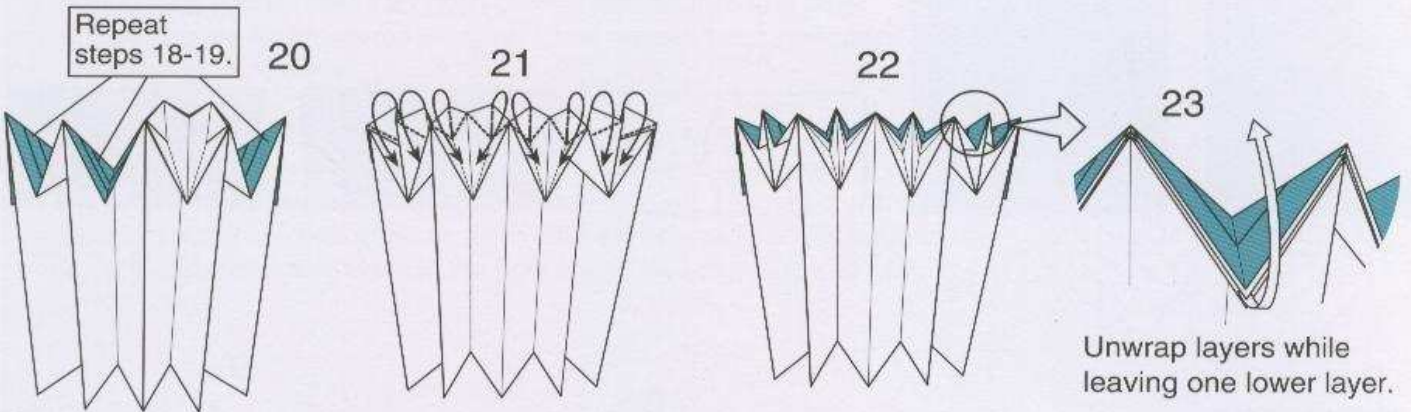
First, you need to decide how fine you would like to make the tail. That defines how many times you have to repeat the steps. Repeat five times for the picture on the left and in the beginning of this book, though the diagram instructs to repeat three times.





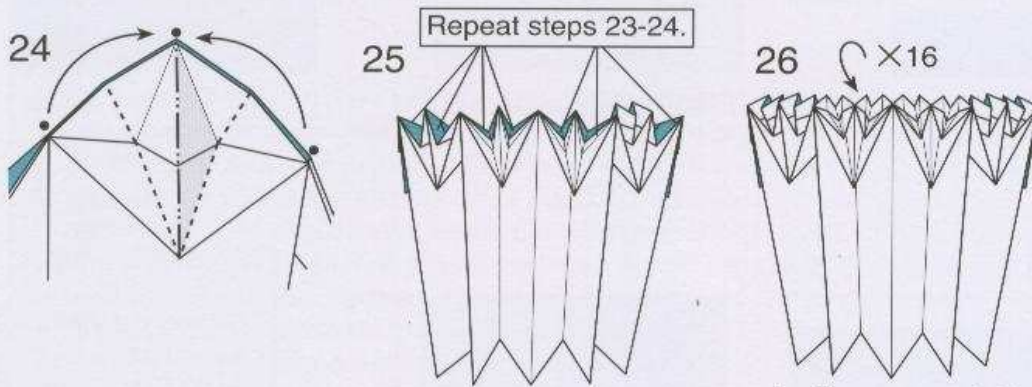
Inside reverse-fold

Unwrap layers while leaving two lower layers.



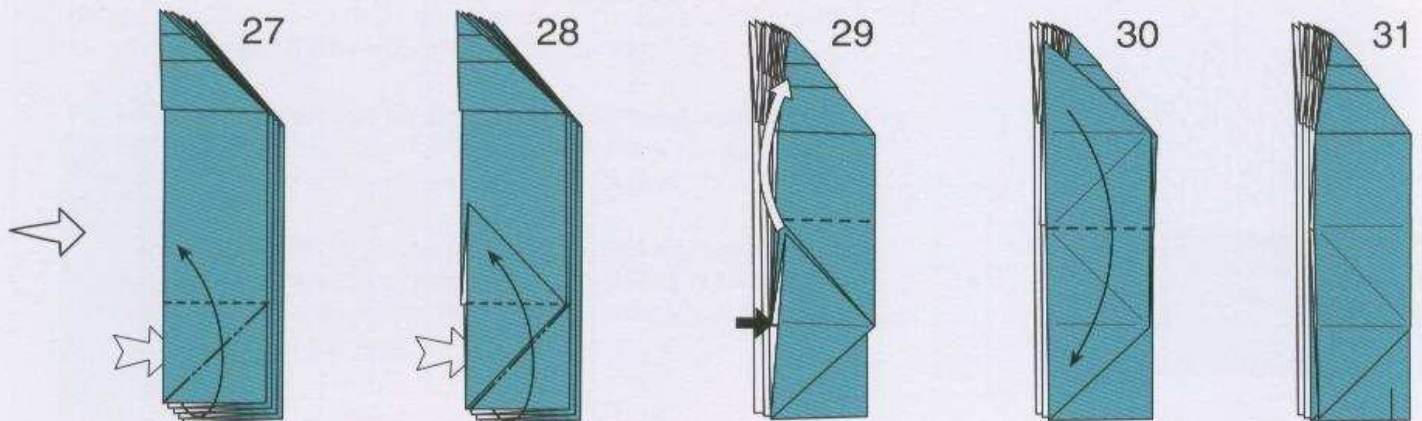
Inside reverse-fold eight times

Unwrap layers while leaving one lower layer.



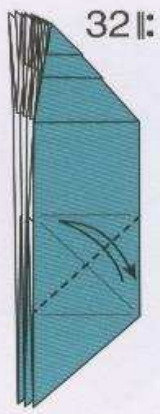
Inside reverse-fold sixteen times

If you have repeated more times at step 13, repeat these steps as well. You can also unwrap the edge of the paper to make rectangles, as in the picture in the beginning of the book.



Stretch and squash to make a trapezoid.

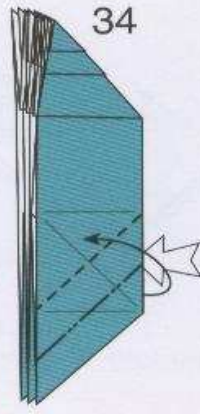
Repeat steps 27-30.

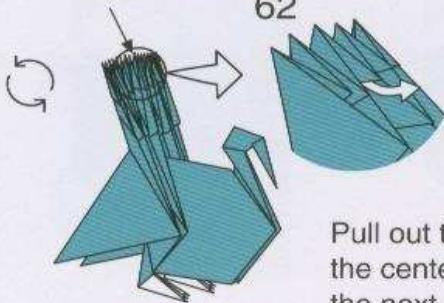


Outside crimp

Fold the point so that it becomes a wattle, not a beak.

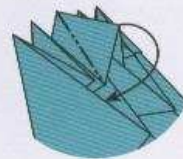

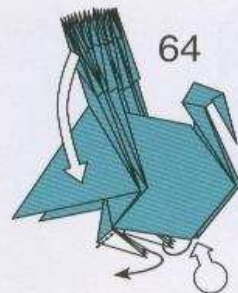


Pull out the small flap at the center and tuck it into the next pocket to lock. (You can omit this step.)

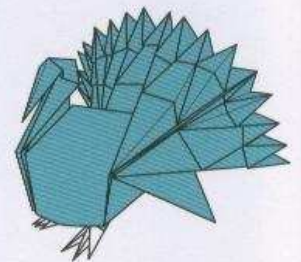
